California DE6 Magnetic Media Reporting

- Provides easy filing of California State DE6 Reports
- Approved by the State of California Employment Development Department



Effective January 1, 1995, California employers who are required to report W2 data to the federal government on magnetic media must also provide their California wage reporting the same way. However, unlike the federal government, California reduces the information on a quarterly basis, with no yearly totaling. Because of this difference, the standard MAS 90 • MAS 200 W2 magnetic media reporting does not fulfill the California requirements. This enhancement allows the user to conform to the California requirements for DE6 reporting on magnetic media as first outlined in Assembly Bill 3086.

Operation:

The format of the program is very similar to the MAS 90 Federal Magnetic Media Reporting program, with additional input fields for "Wage Plan" and "Employee Count" for each month in the quarter. The program gathers its data from the payroll employee tax status file. Since the information comes from the QTD data, the diskette must be produced for each quarter prior to closing the quarter. The generated file has been approved by the State of California Employment Development Department. This enhancement requires the Sage Software Magnetic Media Module.
